Singing in the Face of Death: How the Psalms model and shape our congregational singing You are invited to join us as we consider how the ancient book of Psalms continues to shape and form the Church's worship, and ways that we may benefit from the historic practice of psalm singing. Hear from Dordt communication professor and organist Michael Kearney and guitarist Matthew David Montgomery as they share the ways that they've been able to incorporate the psalter in drastically differing stylistic church contexts.

Haan Auditorium "Singing the Psalms: How the Psalter Speaks to All Church Music Styles" featuring Dr. Michael Kearney & Matthew David Montgomery" Join us for an evening of instrumental and vocal music focusing on the psalter. #### For your information:

Dr. Michael Kearney serves as Assistant Professor of Communication at Dordt University. He is also a pianist, organist, and composer with a special interest in musical settings of the psalms. He has given organ concerts in the U.S., Canada, and the Netherlands focusing on the Dutch tradition of psalmody, collaborating with musicians such as André Knevel and Gert van Hoef. He has also accompanied The Genevans, student choir of Geneva College, in tours across the U.S. and to Northern Ireland, Germany, Austria, the Czech Republic, the Philippines, and Malaysia. He has been an a cappella precentor in a Reformed Presbyterian (Scottish Covenanter) congregation as well as a pianist and organist in multiple other Reformed and Presbyterian churches, and he has led workshops on psalm-singing at multiple churches and conferences. His website and YouTube channel *URC Psalmody* includes more than 600 recordings of psalms, hymns, and organ music.

Matthew Montgomery is a church musician, guitarist, and recording artist who currently serves on staff at Tates Creek Presbyterian Church in Lexington, KY. He has also called both Pittsburgh and Nashville home, where he formerly served at Grove City College and Covenant Presbyterian Church respectively. Matthew writes and records original songs, instrumental works, and congregational psalm-settings, collaborating with artists such as Phil Keaggy, Jeremy Casella, and others. Matthew is husband to Lois, father to Leland, and debtor to mercy alone.
